Polca rápida

Mientras planificaba la publicación de un álbum con música ligera propia, comprobé que las 13 composiciones seleccionadas originalmente duraban en total menos de 60 minutos. Un CD tiene capacidad para 80 minutos, por lo que decidí componer un par de nuevos trozos orquestales. Escribí primero "Día de excursión" y en seguida la "Polca de los atrasados", la cual caracteriza a personas que salen tarde y se esfuerzan luego por llegar a la hora.

Edición de la partitura con el software de notación musical Sibelius: 18 al 28 del mismo mes.

Edición de las partes de orquesta: 30 de agosto al 17 de septiembre del mismo año.

Versión audio con Sibelius y Garritan Personal Orchestra: 17 al 21 de septiembre de 2023.

Quick polka

While planning to release an album of my own light music, I verified that the 13 originally selected compositions lasted in total less than 60 minutes. A CD holds 80 minutes, so I decided to compose a couple of new orchestral pieces. I wrote first "Excursion day" and then the "The belated's polka", which characterizes people who leave late and then strive to arrive on time.
